Paul Fauteux participera au panel MÉDIATION qui se tiendra le mardi 20 juin 2023 à 11h15.

Paul Fauteux pratique le droit, la médiation et l'arbitrage chez CMKZ, un cabinet montréalais spécialisé dans le droit du commerce international et des affaires. Il est l'un des six canadiens à détenir le diplôme de l'Académie de droit international de La Haye. Il enseigne la médiation et la justice participative à l'Université d'Ottawa et a enseigné l'arbitrage commercial international à l'École du Barreau du Québec. Il a été membre de la Commission des relations de travail et de l'emploi dans le secteur public fédéral et est spécialiste du règlement des différends pour le Programme de gestion des différends commerciaux de Services publics et approvisionnements Canada. Il est actuellement membre de la liste du Centre de règlement des différends sportifs du Canada. Il a été diplomate et haut fonctionnaire canadien de 1980 à 2010 et directeur général du Bureau des changements climatiques d'Environnement Canada de 2000 à 2004.

Valère Ndior est professeur à l'Université de Bretagne occidentale, membre de l'Institut universitaire de France, chercheur au centre GEODE - Géopolitique de la Datasphère et Affiliated Fellow au Yale Information Society Project. Ses recherches portent sur le droit international et le numérique. Il dirige le programme *Gouvernance et régulation des réseaux sociaux* (chaire Innovation IUF). Ses travaux actuels portent sur les réseaux sociaux, la modération de contenus, les coupures d'Internet, la régulation de l'intelligence artificielle, la cybersécurité. Il a notamment participé au Groupe de travail *Legal Frameworks* du Global Internet Forum to Counter Terrorism et au Comité consultatif de l'Appel de Christchurch. Valère est également président du Réseau francophone de droit international (Concours Charles-Rousseau).

Maria Pernas will participate in the BUSINESSES AS INTERNATIONAL LAW ACTORS panel which will be held on Monday 19 June 2023 at 11:15 am.

Maria Pernas is member of the Capgemini Group Executive Committee in charge of Legal, Commercial and Contract Management. Previously, she was Senior Vice-President, Group General Counsel Operations at Atos, where she was leading the Regional legal teams and Contract Management. Maria was also Group Diversity Program Manager.

After starting her career as external legal advisor at Price Waterhouse in Madrid, Maria joined Sema Group (now Atos), where she was appointed to the role of General Counsel Iberia and South America, and worldwide General Counsel for the Major Events and Entertainment business unit. In 2004 Maria took over the position of Vice-President General Counsel South Europe, Middle East, Africa and South America at the Rome office, while keeping her previous responsibilities as General Counsel Major Events and Entertainment. In 2008 Maria moved to Paris and became responsible for the legal support to Major Contracts and, afterwards, Corporate Legal Affairs, Compliance and Litigations at worldwide level. In 2013 Maria was appointed Deputy Group General Counsel.

Maria is admitted at the Madrid Bar Association. She is member of the Boards of Directors of Cercle Montesquieu (France) and the European Association for Women in Leadership ("WIL"). She is former Vice-President of ACC Europe.

Vasilka Sancin, Ph.D., is a Full (tenured) Professor of International Law, Head of Department of International Law and Director of the Institute for International Law and International Relations at University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Law. She is a member (2022-2025) of the UN Human Rights Council Advisory Committee, and served (2019-2022) as a member and Vice-Chair of the UN Human Rights Committee. Among others, she serves as an *ad hoc* judge at the European court of Human Rights; an arbitrator and a Bureau member of the Court of Conciliation and Arbitration (OSCE); an expert of the OSCE Moscow mechanism on Human Rights; a President of the Slovene Branch of International Law Association (ILA) and a co-chair of the ILA's Committee on International Migration and International Law.
